What is Healthcare Fraud, Error, and Abuse?

Fraud is false information given to receive payments for services not provided.

Error is a mistake that may be corrected after a call to your medical provider or supplier.

Abuse is a healthcare provider or supplier recommendation for services or equipment not medically necessary.

How SMP Helps:

SMP **empowers and assists** Medicare beneficiaries, their families, and caregivers to prevent, detect, and report healthcare fraud, errors, and abuse. Trained staff in each county and Baltimore City can help answer your questions and teach how to spot and report abuse in the Medicare program.

SMP reaches **millions** of consumers each year and helps recover **billions** of federal dollars lost to healthcare fraud, error and abuse.
